A story of hope and recovery

When Trey was in high school, he began using alcohol on a consistent basis. Though not realizing it at the time, he had begun to construct a life around his alcohol use. Before he knew it, alcohol had him on the cusp of losing everything. He was very overweight and on multiple medications, including blood pressure and cholesterol medications. He avoided going to the doctor for fear of what they might say or find out. The bottom line was, he didn't care about himself. He only cared about the alcohol. But after hitting rock bottom, Trey was able to turn to Lionrock Behavioral Health, Inc., and their virtual in-home treatment program for care. - Performs poorly at work or school
- Experiences unusual mood changes

/// Physical Signs

- Rapid weight gain or loss
- Inability to sleep or being awake at unusual times
- Low or no energy
- Depressed or anxious


